For the past 15 years, Mrs. Minichino has worked as a specialist in tobacco treatment providing cessation counseling and professional training on “Ask, Advise, and Refer: Brief Intervention Model”.

This CDC evidence based best practice is a three-minute intervention to improve assessing and addressing the use of any tobacco product, including e-cigarettes. **Tobacco Free for a Healthy New Jersey** offers a free 1-hour comprehensive training that helps clinicians have these difficult conversations with patients/clients. This training will provide updated tools and strategies with an overview of easy referral process to New Jersey’s free cessation services.
