Q&AWith Your Provider

Suggested questions you may want to ask your provider during your next visit.



It's important to have an open discussion with your health care provider. Having specific questions to guide your discussion can help you better understand the diagnosis and help improve your treatment outcomes.

Here are a few simple questions to consider during your next screening appointment.

General questions you can ask during your appointment:

ı.	What kind of cancer do I have?
2.	Where do you think the cancer started in my body and has it spread?
3.	Do you know what stage of cancer I have?
4.	Can you explain to me what the stages are and mean?
5.	Do I need another test or a second opinion?
6.	What are my chances of surviving this cancer?
7.	What are my treatment options? What do you recommend?
8.	How soon do I need to start treatment?
9.	What kind of treatments are available?
10	. Will I need surgery? What are the risks of having a procedure?
11.	How will treatment affect my work, family, and daily activities?

12. Should I be on a special diet?		
13.	Will my insurance cover the full cost of treatment? Are there payment plans or programs that can assists with copays/out-of-pocket fees?	
14.	What support services are available to me and my family?	
15.	Who can I call if I have additional questions when I get home?
